# Direction No. 8 of the Committee for Health & Social Care issued under the Emergency Powers (Coronavirus) (General Provision) (No. 2) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Regulations, 2020

This Direction is issued by the Committee for Health & Social Care, in exercise of its powers under regulations 13(1)(a) and (b) and 14(3) of the above Regulations and following consultation with the Medical Officer of Health:-

## 1. Variation of Direction No. 7.

- (1) In paragraph 8 of the Fifth Schedule to Direction No. 7
  - (a) in subparagraph (1) for "(2) and (3)", substitute "(2), (3) and (3A)", and
  - (b) immediately after subparagraph (3), insert the following subparagraph –
- "(3A) The third condition is that the childminding services are provided only in respect of a child or children of one or more essential workers.".

## 2. Revocation of Direction No. 6.

Direction No. 6 of the Committee for Health & Social Care, issued under the Emergency Powers (Coronavirus) (General Provision) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Regulations, 2020 on 6<sup>th</sup> May 2020, is revoked.

## 3. Application.

This Direction applies throughout the Bailiwick.

## 4. Duration.

This Direction has effect from Monday 18<sup>th</sup> May, 2020 until 2359 hours on Friday 29<sup>th</sup> May, 2020.

## **Explanatory Note**

Direction No. 8 is made by the Committee *for* Health & Social Care ("the Committee") on 18<sup>th</sup> May, 2020 further to powers conferred on it by the Emergency Powers (Coronavirus) (General Provision) (No. 2) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Regulations, 2020 as made by the Civil Contingencies Authority under the Civil Contingencies (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 2012.

The Direction amends Direction No. 7, as made by the Committee on 15<sup>th</sup> May 2020, by clarifying that the disapplication of the prohibition on gatherings, which applies for the purpose of enabling childminding services to be provided by registered childminders and authorised nannies, applies only in respect of the children of essential workers. It also revokes Direction No. 6, as made by the Committee on 6<sup>th</sup> May 2020, which Direction No. 7 is intended to replace.
